

Updated 16th July with revised times

We are delighted to advise you that the Diocese has given us permission to open the church from next week **ONLY** for private prayer & reflection.

**The church will be open
Tuesday 2pm - 3pm
& Friday 11am-12pm**

There are very strict protocols that we MUST follow to enable this so we do ask that EVERYONE who is planning to come reads and adheres to the following instructions.

- Please **DO NOT** come if you are unwell, even if you don't think it is Covid-19
- If you do come to pray and are then taken ill in the next week please advise the Operations Manager on ops@stpaulsdorking.org.uk or 07767 778227
- Please bring with you **everything** you need, there will be no bibles, prayer books or order of services available.
- Please bring a pen as you will be asked to sign in
- Please be aware that **ALL the toilets and kitchen are out of bounds** and are all locked
- Enter through the west driveway, wait in line 2 meters apart to the West doors
- Enter when advised through the main entrance
- log in (using your own pen) in the book inside
- **Either** put on gloves as you enter the building and keep them on the entire time you are inside
- **Or** hand sanitise your hands on entering and before leaving
- If any other people are inside you must keep a distance of two metres between you
- Everyone must wipe down every surface they have touched with the wipes provided. These MUST stay on the table for others
- Do not place anything in any waste bins or leave anything behind that you have brought with you or wipes you have used
- Follow the arrows round and sit in a chair (not the nearest please otherwise others will have to move past you).

There will be a warden on duty to help/remind you of these instructions when you arrive.
